These expressive food-friendly wines are shamelessly aromatic show-offs and their exotic flavors are far from shy. The selections range from dry to fruity, but each has vivid acidity, a common feature that aids the ability to pair them with a broad range of food. And, believe me, they know their way around a table. Once you've let them in, they're here for the long haul.

- BIN 25 Bucci Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi** *Marche, Italy* 37
Fruity and floral...outstanding acidity. A layered bouquet of vanilla, butterscotch, almonds, vibrant citrus and Golden Delicious apple flavors dance on the palate.
- BIN 26 Weissburgunder, Heidi Schrock** *Neusiedlersee-Huggeland, Austria* 35
Pacific oysters in a glass! All of Heidi's whites have a teensy bit of residual sugar, which does them nothing but good. Maize and corn notes make this wine very racy and very ripe.
- BIN 27 "The Other" White Wine** *Lodi, California* 30
Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Viognier bottled together to make your mouth water for mussels. Vibrant color with aromas of apples, pears and a hint of vanilla; flavors of ripe pear, tropical fruit and homemade lemon pie lead to a long, totally seductive and unforgettable finish.
- BIN 28 X Winery - White X** *North Coast, California* 29
A unique blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Muscat Blanc, Chardonnay and Roussanne, this white will not disappoint even the pickiest palate. Apricot and honey aromas play nicely with the citrus notes and bright acidity making this a perfect pair for almost any dish.
- BIN 29 Ken Forrester Petit Chenin Blanc** *Stellenbosch, South Africa* 6.5 22
Perfect everyday drinking wine. 100% Chenin Blanc boasting fresh ripe melon with a mellow, round, mild fruit palate and refreshingly long finish.
- BIN 30 Crios - Torrontes** *Cafayate, Argentina* 28
Enticing aromas that are strikingly similar to Viognier, with hints of peach pit, white pear, flowers and orange citrus fruit. Plenty of body for a wine that shows such delicate aromas and flavors. Fruity, floral and yet still quite dry, this wine has to be tasted to be believed.
- BIN 31 Molly Dooker "The Violinist"** *McLaren Vale, Australia* 37
Named for the days when Sarah was made to play the violin right-handed in school, (so that she didn't poke her right-handed neighbors in the eye with her bow), is the only white wine made by Molly Dooker. A gorgeous Verdelho with a lovely, creamy texture and long, persistent flavors of honeysuckle, pineapple and citrus. It virtually leaps out of the glass.
- BIN 32 Civello White** *California* 32
"Sexier than a Pinot Grigio, naughtier than a Chardonnay." This blend of Verdelho, Pinot Gris, Gewurztraminer and Chardonnay is refreshing and exciting; dry, yet crisp and full bodied.
- BIN 33 Chateau Gres St. Paul 'Grange Philippe' Rosé** *Vin de Pays d'Oc, France* 8 31
More fruit-forward than other rosé offerings with lots of juicy, intense red fruits, yet as rosé always should, it finishes dry. Hey fellas, REAL men do drink pink wine!

German Style Riesling

These expressive wines are aromatic show-offs and their exotic flavors are far from shy. This selection varies from dry to fruity, but each has vivid acidity--a common feature that aids the ability to pair with a broad range of food.

BIN 34 Selbach - Fish Label Kabinett Riesling **Mosel, Germany** 8 31

On the dry side, it is loaded with fruit and plum-blossom and has amazing length and depth. This great vintage quality may never be equaled again. As fruity as a key-lime pie and as long as The Brothers Karamozov.

BIN 35 Chateau Ste. Michelle Eroica Riesling **Columbia Valley, Washington** 38

Named for Beethoven's Third Symphony for it is a beautiful concert of old and new world style Riesling. Enjoy the light taste of mandarin orange and lime on a strong base of mineral and slate.

BIN 36 Rudi Wiest 'Rhein' Riesling **Rheingau, Germany** 28

Seductive, tropical aroma, spiked with orange blossoms, peaches and apricots on the palate. Perfectly balanced with nervy, vibrant acidity leaving a mouth-watering, medium to dry finish. Great as a sipping wine or to accompany grilled meat or fish.

Pinot Noir & Grenache

Pinot Noir, "The Summer Grape" vs. Grenache, "The Winter Grape". When conditions are favorable, both can yield an amazing array of sensuous aromas and complex flavors such as cherries, plums, strawberries, cranberries, currants, violets, rose petals, chocolate, truffles and game.

BIN 37 Viridian Pinot Noir **Willamette Valley, Oregon** 10.5 39

The rich ruby color of this Pinot makes it almost impossible to see through the glass. The intense aromas of black cherry and pomegranate linger on the tongue and leave you with a hint of spice that will knock your socks off.

BIN 38 Saddlerock Pinot Noir **Malibu, California** 10 38

A true Central Coast blend, this elegant Pinot Noir exhibits a delicate balance of bright fruit, tea leaf and clove. Whether sipped alone or enjoyed with a meal, it is the perfect compliment for any occasion.

BIN 39 Buena Vista Estate Pinot Noir **Carneros, California** 53

Serves up excellent ripe fruit flavors that are long and lavish on the palate; tremendous finish. This elegant Pinot Noir exhibits bright acidity coupled with raspberry and plum overtones.

BIN 40 Lutea Russian River Pinot Noir (Organic) **Russian River Valley, California** 64
