Pop Goes the Weasel! (Sparkling)

By Glass Bottle

Sparkling wine is produced around the world and is best suited for cooler growing regions. Styles range from light, fruity and lean to rich, creamy, lush and complex.

BIN1 Laurent-Perrier Ultra Brut *Champagne, France* **83**

Absolutely bone dry....Champagne in its most natural form. Delicate finish leaves the palate fresh, while its subtle balance makes it a remarkably versatile wine. Its capacity to bring out flavors in food makes it ideal as an aperitif or paired with dessert.

BIN 2 Moët & Chandon Rose *Champagne, France* **89**

The French got it right with this one! Fragrant aromas of freshly crushed nectarine, cherry and red currant, with hints of sugar candy and rosemary. Complements rich desserts, spicy cuisines and cream sauces.

BIN 3 Louis Perdrier Brut *Burgundy, France* **11 35**

With honeyed, tropical fruit on the nose, a slight sweetness and good acidity, this sparkling blend of French white grapes is a sincere crowd pleaser.

BIN 4 Chartogne Taillet Rose *Champagne, France* **95**

Virtually luscious, it's so brioche-y and creamy. Lovers of old-style Champagnes should look closely, as it has a silken complexity that's consistent enough to infer the design of a knowing hand.

BIN 5 Gatinois Brut 'Grand Cru' NV *Champagne, France* **61**

Made from old vine Pinot Noir with just a touch of Chardonnay, Gatinois is robust enough to hold up to a meal, with fruity flavors that make it a perfect match for warm weather.

Sauvignon Blanc & Semillon

Nothing says spring or summer like fresh clean aromas and flavors, except maybe the weather. Since we have the weather now, let these four unique wines pay tribute to the seasons. They'll bring the great outdoors right into your glass. It's time for a picnic!

BIN 6 Manifesto! *Suisun Valley, California* **30**

There's usable advice on this bottle...."great wine should be easy to drink-and easy to open." Citrus peel, grapefruit and pine needles awaken the senses and mingle with secondary notes of pineapple, guava and gardenia. The taste is true Sauvignon Blanc; Meyer lemon, pink grapefruit and orange peel coat the palate with a perfect dose of acidity.

BIN 7 Mohua Sauvignon Blanc *Marlborough, New Zealand* **32**

Grassy, flinty, with a kivi-cart full of refreshing lime and pomelo fruit. Not super complex, but surprisingly balanced with a pleasant, lingering finish.

BIN 8 Chartron La Fleur Blanc *Bordeaux, France* **26**

Made with only Sauvignon Blanc, the peach-skin and dry floral aromas mixed with the minerally grapefruit flavors and the mouth-puckering sensation and dry finish, make this a perfect match for shellfish.

The name Meomi, (pronounced May-ob-mee) means "coast" in the language of the native Wappo and Yuki tribes, and Meomi vines draw from the abundant choices presented along California's cool, lengthy Pacific border. This is seriously amazing Pinot for the price and has everything a great Pinot Noir should: aromas of earthy red fruits, complex flavors of black tea, bing cherry and subtle oak spice and just a hint of smoky oak and licorice.
